Predict Performance and Inform Instruction

Lexia® RAPID™ Assessment, developed in partnership with the Florida Center for Reading Research, is specifically designed to help educators meet the need for meaningful data that predicts student outcomes and informs instructional decisions.

Districts and schools use RAPID to:

- Screen all K-12 students for end-of-year reading success with grade-specific tasks that adapt based on individual, real-time performance
- Determine students' profiles of strengths and weaknesses in critical reading and language skills
- Monitor change in student performance over time

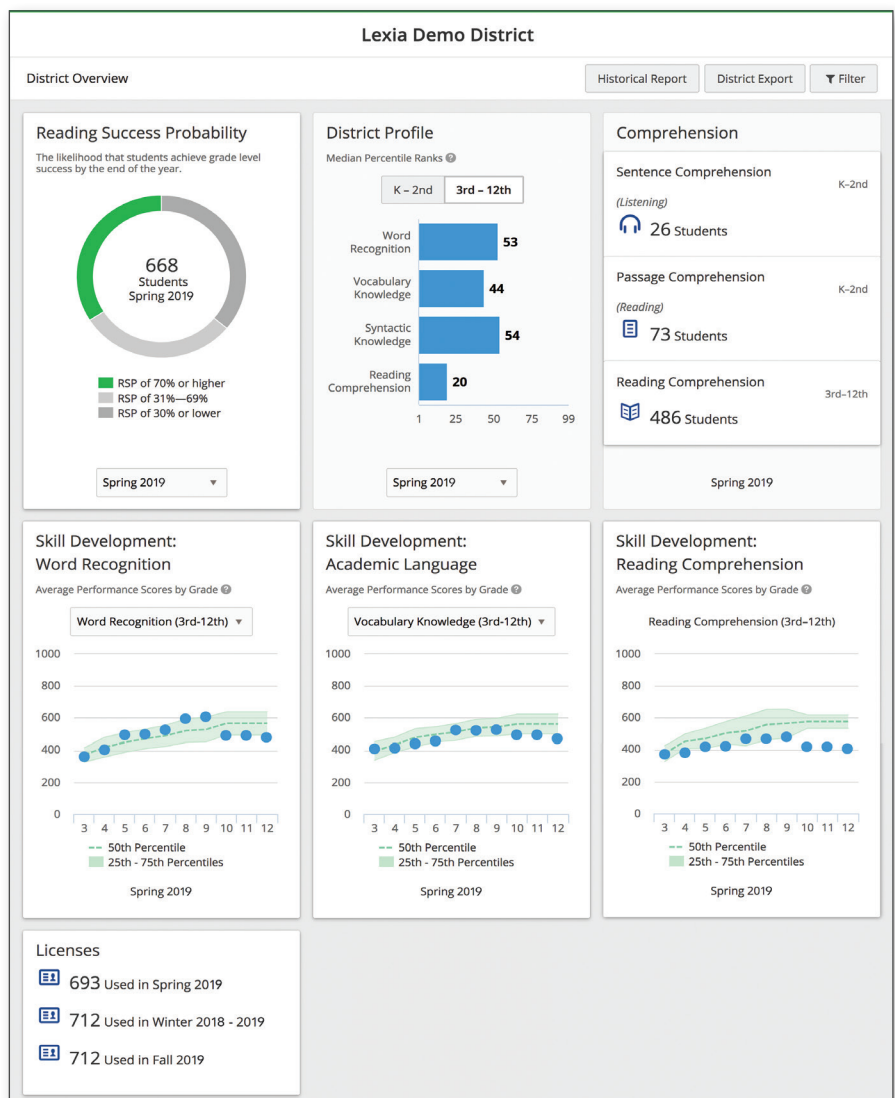
Immediate Data Reporting

Instantaneous reporting, free from paper scoring and data entry, saves educators' valuable time and resources. As soon as students complete RAPID tasks, data are available online for review.

District and School Reports provide analyses of students' reading performance over time for grades K-12.

Class Reports show individual student data as well as aggregates of all student scores to provide an analysis of class performance over time and group students for instructional planning.

Student Reports show each student's screening task scores and identify the student's Instructional Focus.

K-12 Reading and Language Tasks

As a universal screener, Lexia RAPID Assessment reliably and efficiently measures the skills that are highly predictive of reading development and comprehension at each grade level across three domains: Word Recognition, Academic Language, and Reading Comprehension.

- For grades K-2, RAPID assesses students' foundational skills within each domain, using individually-administered tasks that span a continuum of reading and language development
- For grades 3-12, RAPID can be group administered to assess students' complex knowledge, understanding, and application of skills that predict successful reading comprehension

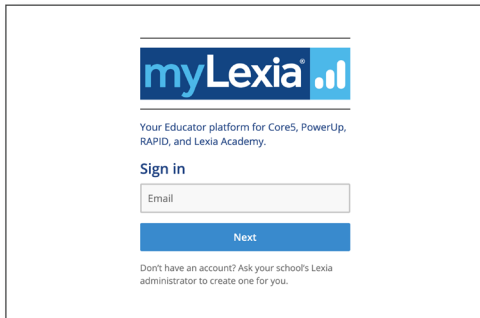
	Task	Grade	Purpose
Word Recognition	Phonological Awareness (Blending)	K	Measures students' phonological awareness skills by assessing their ability to blend a series of isolated sounds (e.g., phonemes or word parts) into a single word.
	Letter Sounds	K (fall, winter)	Measures students' knowledge of letter sounds, including common consonant digraphs.
	Word Reading	K (spring) 1, 2	Measures students' ability to read words, including sight words and words with regular spelling.
	Spelling	2	Measures students' ability to spell single and multi-syllabic words.
	Word Recognition	3-12	Measures students' abilities to synthesize the component skills of decoding (reading), encoding (spelling), and vocabulary for effective word recognition.
Academic Language	Vocabulary Pairs	K, 1, 2	Measures students' understanding of the relationships between words, concepts, and categories.
	Following Directions	1, 2	Measures students' ability to interpret verbal directions containing various basic concepts.
	Vocabulary Knowledge	3-12	Measures students' ability to apply morphological strategies, including knowledge of prefixes, suffixes, and roots, in order to comprehend new vocabulary.
	Syntactic Knowledge	3-12	Measures sentence-level inferencing and use of connective words, pronouns, and subject-verb agreement.
Reading Comprehension	Sentence Comprehension *	K (fall, winter)	Measures students' ability to interpret verbal sentences of increasing length and complexity.
	Passage Comprehension *	K (spring) 1, 2	Describes students' reading accuracy, fluency, and comprehension.
	Reading Comprehension	3-12	Measures students' deep understanding of both narrative and informational text.

Targeted And Time-Efficient

In grades K-2, most students will finish RAPID screening tasks in under 25 minutes. For grades 3-12, the majority of students will finish RAPID screening tasks within a typical class period of 30 to 50 minutes.

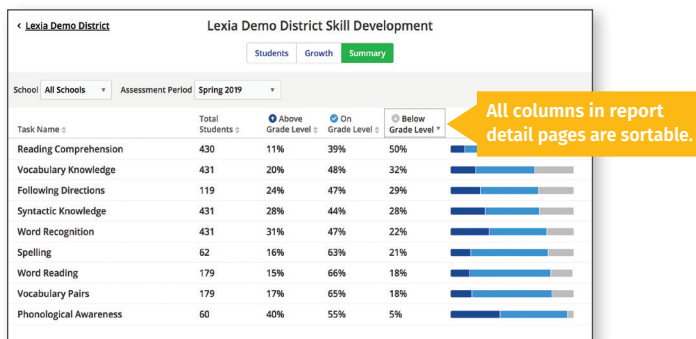

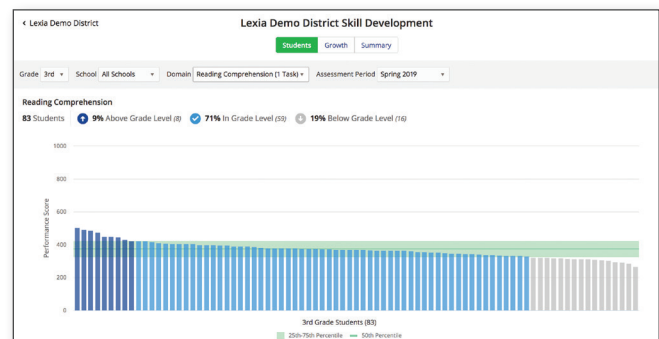

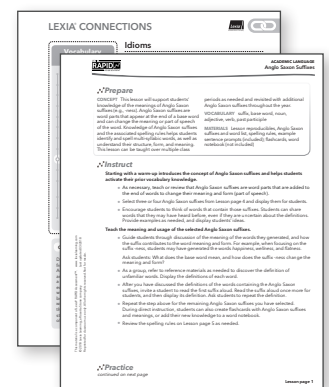
